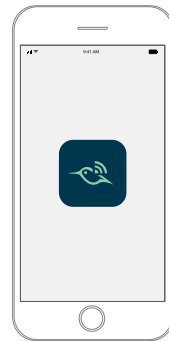
Charge the battery to 100%.

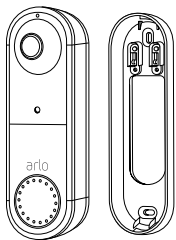
Download the Arlo app from the App Store or Google Play.

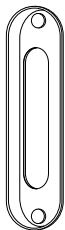
Follow the step by step instructions in the Arlo app to install.

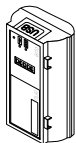

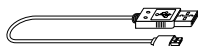
Angled mounting plate



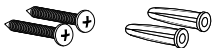
Release pin (keep

Tools

- A Phillips screwdriver is required to install the doorbell (not provided).
- You might also benefit from having a drill, a level, and a ladder (to reach the chime).

If you choose to wire your doorbell

If you choose to wire your wire-free Essential Video Doorbell, the voltage must be 8 – 24VAC and a 10VA transformer is required.

If your voltage doesn't meet the power requirements, and you need to install or upgrade a transformer, contact a licensed electrician or visit arlo.com for information about installation services.
