

B. Bluetooth usage

- Step 1: Turn on the keyboard by using the the power switch on the upper right side.
- Step 2: Long press any set of FN + 1 (or 2 or 3) to start the paring process, the indicator light will start flashing.
- Step 3: Search for the name "Bluetooth 3.0 keyboard" in the Bluetooth divice list and click pair. Upon pairing, the indicator light on your keyboard stops blinking and remains steady.



★ Note: The Keyboard can be connected to three devices, by pressing FN + 1/2/3 you switch between connected divices.

Note: Long press FN + 1/2/3 to start the bluetooth paring process

★ Note: To reset the keyboard Long press FN + ESC to recover factory settings of the keyboard. (this operation will clear previously connected devices)

- 1. The white light flickers once Keyboard-Power-on indication
- 2. The white light flickers continuously—— Paring mode
- 3. The light is red Keyboard is charging
- 4. The yellow light flickers Low keyboard power
